
## Sunba PTZ Controller 3D Keyboard Quick Start Guide

Warning: Voltage reaches the joystick cannot exceed 9V. Overpower will immediately damage the keyboard and void the warranty.

Step by Step Video Tutorial: analog.sunba.net Turn Buzzer Off: 66+PGM

Please first be familiar with the operations of devices connected to this keyboard such as PTZ camera. To use the keyboard, please set the same 1) baud rate, 2) protocol and 3) address bit as the corresponding PTZ camera on the keyboard menu. Please use "0~255+ CAM" to match the address bit of the camera in keyboard. For Sunba cameras, the default address bit of the camera is 1 (so you will need to press 1 + CAM); for Sunba cameras, upon power on, the video will display its current address.

Press "MENU" button to enter the keyboard menu. Manipulate the rocker to choose the corresponding menu. Press the "EXIT" button to exit the menu. Note: For the rocker, use upward and downward to choose the menu, left to return to main menu and right to confirm.


